Course description (up to 600 words)	<p>The course explores the ways in which technology impacts our lives and the surrounding world. It examines the positive and negative effects of technology on individuals, communities, and the environment, and considers the ethical and social implications of technological advancements.</p> <p>The course begins by briefly examining the historical and cultural context of technology, and how it has shaped human society over time. It then moves on to explore the current state of technology, including the latest developments in areas such as artificial intelligence, social media, cybersecurity, and robotics.</p> <p>Throughout the course, students will learn about the impact of technology on various aspects of society, including the economy, politics, and culture. Special emphasis will be placed on the implications of technology use in education.</p> <p>They will also examine the challenges posed by technology, such as the digital divide, privacy concerns, and the environmental impact of technological progress.</p> <p>One important issue the course addresses is the ethical considerations surrounding the development and use of technology. Students will explore questions such as who benefits from technological advancements, who is left behind, and who bears the costs and risks of technological innovation.</p> <p>By the end of the course, students will have a deeper understanding of the complex relationship between technology and society, and will be equipped to engage in critical discussions about the role of technology in shaping our future.</p>
